
Map of Russia and neighbouring countries

(МОСКВА).





Exotic animals and plant (рамра- панда, вамама-банан etc)

Technical, computer terms (PRINTER-ПРИНТЕР etc)

Politics and Business (BANK-БАНК etc)

Original Russian words in English cosmos, sputnik, borsch etc

- HOC (nos)
- БРАТ (brat), CECTPA(sestra), MAMA(mama), ПАПА(papa), БАБУШКА(babushka)
- ВОДА (vada), СОЛНЦЕ (sontse)

- ШКОЛА (shkola), ЭКЗАМЕН (examen)
- KOT (kot)

'KISS' rule in reading and writing 'Keep it Simple and Sound'

In majority of cases every letter is read in only one way

e.g.'A' as in 'art' (not as in 'apple' or 'table')

'C' as in 'cinema' and never as in 'car' or in 'chair'

Sometimes 2 letters are expressed by 1letter in Russian, e.g. sh=Ш ch=Ч

Or 1 letter -'G' or 'J' as in George or John is expressed by 2 Russian letters 'ДЖ' **

If a letter is not pronounced you do not write it in Russian (like 'e' in 'Jane').
