

LOCAL AUTHORITY STRATEGIES 2017: 1+2 IMPLEMENTATION

- Scottish Government would like to thank all Local Authorities for your work to provide all the responses as quickly as you did. We appreciate how difficult this is. Also our team both at Education Scotland and in Scottish Government would like to thank you for your candour. All 32 LA have responded.

- We are currently undertaking analysis. Some initial results are:
 - Over 75% of primary schools have PLL in place from P1
 - 90% of all primary schools have PLL in place from P4 to P7
 - By the end of session 2017-18, 11 out of 32 LA will have P1-P7 in place as standard
 - By the end of 2020-21, almost all LA will have PLL in place as standard
 - Majority of LA aim to achieve L3 as standard between 2019-21
 - Most LA focussing on consolidation of L2, before looking at L3 provision
 - L2 Primary : French, Spanish, Gaelic (L)
 - L3 Primary : Spanish, French, German
 - L2 Secondary : French, Spanish, German, Gaelic (L)
 - L3 Secondary : Spanish, German, French
 - An emerging diversity is showing in L3 through variety of other languages being seen: Mandarin, Scots, Doric, Japanese, Norge, Latin, Shetlandic, Romanian, BSL

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
