## Scottish Languages Employability Award

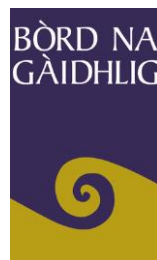
- To replace the Business Language Champions scheme with a rigorous, verified Award which empowers schools and learners.
