

GERMAN OUTDOORS WORKSHOP FOR PRIMARY PUPILS (P3 – P6)

Outdoor learning provides a valuable, often non-competitive learning environment as well as an opportunity to develop independence and self-confidence. Learning in the outdoors re-enforces a positive attitude to education and encourages young people to take greater responsibility for their own learning. The outdoor environment can be a highly motivational place for the development of communication skills. Research has shown that children's use of language is five times greater outdoors than indoors.

WHAT DOES IT ENTAIL

- 60 minutes of active learning in an outdoor environment
- physical & imaginative play
- problem solving & team work
- learning German vocabulary and about German culture

WHO IS IT FOR?

Suitable for all primary school classes as a taster for complete beginners or to build on pupils' previous knowledge of German. Number of participants: 30 (max)

HOW DOES IT WORK?

A German native speaker will visit your school which can be held at your school grounds or a nearby green space. The children need to be equipped for all weather. All materials will be supplied.

The outdoor areas we aim to use could be the school grounds, a local park, or nearby woodland. This does not involve a long journey, cost or high risk activity. The programme for each teaching unit is tailored to the age of the pupils and is for learners with no or very little knowledge of German.
